This consent form has been provided after you/your camper(s) has/have been registered and to inform you of the guidelines and activities that will apply during you/your camper(s)' stay at Camp Omagh.

Please sign the form at the end, and initial each page to indicate that the document has been read. If the camper is under 18 years of age or cannot give consent or understand the issue of consent, a parent or legal guardian must give permission.

PeaceKeepers Agreement

Camp Omagh is a place for faith, fun and adventure. The following rules set out the responsibilities of each camper.

1. All campers are expected to participate in every activity unless the weekly director/program manager grants an exemption.
2. No camper is allowed to leave the campgrounds without the permission of the weekly director/program manager. (even if over the age of 18)
3. Campers should always be under the counsellors supervision, except when they are in Bible classes.

4. Hiking will be permitted only in groups with a staff member designated and approved by the program manager.
5. Water activities and water safety: Swimming is limited to the designated swimming period for all campers and only when a lifeguard is on duty. Campers must wear a beach towel or robe over a swimsuit to and from the pool house/washroom building. Horseplay of any kind is not tolerated in the pool area.
6. Each camper is responsible for always keeping the dorms and camp premises clean and neat.
7. Each camper is to know and abide by the daily schedule.
8. Boys and girls are not to enter or visit the cabins of the opposite sex. Campers must not enter the McKerlie house or cabins of other campers or staff members without permission from the director, manager, or groundskeeper.
9. There should not be any dating between staff members and campers. Relationships between campers should focus on developing Christian friendships and contributing to the entire community of campers.
10. Campers and staff members are always expected to dress modestly.
 - Shirts should have sleeves, or straps with minimum 5cm width, and cover midriff.
 - Shorts should not be above mid-thigh
 - No skin-tight or torn clothing.
 - No logos or messages on clothing promoting alcohol or drugs; are offensive, crude or demeaning and that promote a non-Biblical ethic.
 - Swimwear should cover midriff (one piece is preferred), no bikinis or speedo brief type suits.

The Program Manager and Weekly Directors will exercise their discretion in determining the acceptability of all apparel.

11. How you come is how you will leave. There will be no body modifications, i.e. body piercing, tattoos, hair colouring, haircutting, etc.
12. Electronic devices are often a valuable and necessary part of children's educational and social development. Camp Omagh values time away from devices and works to provide a fun environment from what children may experience at home or school. We want our campers to experience things like sports and other outdoor activities where we get our hands dirty! Therefore, **please do not bring any electronics to camp** such as mobile phones, laptops, tablets, etc. Camp Omagh will consider special accommodations on a case-by-case basis.
13. No visits are allowed during camp from peer-aged friends except in case of emergency.
14. The possession and/or use of drugs, alcohol, vaping equipment, cannabis or cannabis products, or tobacco, in any form, is not permitted and will be considered a cause for dismissal from camp.

15. Gambling will not be permitted in any form or by any means and will be considered a cause for dismissal from camp.
16. The use of profanity and obscene language is prohibited, and repeated use will be grounds for dismissal from the camp.
17. The use of any form of violence (fighting, wrestling, or other intimidating behaviour) will not be tolerated and will be considered cause for dismissal. The use of threatening or intimidating behaviour (hazing) toward other campers will not be tolerated and regarded as cause for dismissal.
18. No pranks are permitted that embarrass, harass, or harm anyone. No pranks are permitted that damage personal or camp property. No graffiti or defacing of personal or camp property is allowed.
19. Immoral conduct, sexual harassment, and/or sexual violence will be considered cause for dismissal.

Immoral conduct is improper touching and/or activity of a sexual nature.

Sexual harassment is verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature that creates an intimidating, hostile, or offensive environment.

Sexual violence is a physical act of aggression that includes a sexual act or a sexual purpose.

Camp Omagh will interpret sexual harassment and sexual violence incidents in terms of how the victim feels rather than the intent of the person committing the offence.

20. Campers and/or their family will be held accountable and responsible for paying for any property damage caused by the camper.
21. Campers can be dismissed at any time at the sole discretion of Camp Omagh or its staff for any reason.

REFUND POLICY

The deposit is not refundable.

If a camper violates the Peacekeeper Agreement, authorized personnel will dismiss them from the property, and Camp Omagh will provide no refund.

A pro-rated refund will be applied if a camper must withdraw due to sickness.

All programs require a minimum number of participants before they will run. Camp Omagh will refund 100% of the camp fee plus the deposit if a week is canceled.

WAIVER AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY

1. Subject. Camper recognizes and expressly agrees that participating in any adventure, sport or activity associated with the out-of-doors is inherently dangerous. Further, Camper acknowledges that certain safety precautions must be followed by staff and other campers; but, even strict adherence to those procedures does not guarantee nor does Camp Omagh guarantee Camper's safety.
2. Waiver and Release from Liability. The Camper/Parent/Guardian understands that Camp Omagh assumes no responsibility for injuries or illnesses that Camper may sustain,
 - a) as a result of the Camper's physical condition;
 - b) resulting from Camper's participation in the activity;
 - c) as a result of another Camper's or third person's actions; or
 - d) due to the Camper's use of Camp Omagh facilities, field, and/or equipment in connection with this activity.

The Camper/Parent/Guardian releases and agrees to hold harmless, defend and indemnify Camp Omagh and its directors, officers, employees and agents from and against claims for personal injury (including loss of life) and all other losses or damages (except those caused entirely by the gross negligence or intentional conduct of Camp Omagh) that the Camper may suffer as a result of their participation and/or enrolment in Camp Omagh activities.

3. Property Loss. The Camper/Parent/Guardian understands and agrees that Camp Omagh is not responsible for personal property lost, damaged, or stolen in connection with this activity.
4. Binding Effect. This Agreement shall be binding upon the Camper/Parent/Guardian, their heirs, estate, successors, and legal representatives.
5. Entire Agreement. This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties. This Agreement shall not be modified or amended except by an agreement signed by both parties.
6. Acceptance. If any portions of this waiver and release are invalid, the Camper/Parent/Guardian agrees the remaining terms shall continue to be in full legal force and effect. The

Camper/Parent/Guardian understands and agrees that this Waiver and Release is binding upon my heirs and me, estates and legal representatives.

Moreover, I/we understand that temporary emergency measures may be necessary to safeguard my/our camper/s' health, and do hereby authorize and request Camp Omagh personnel to administer or supervise such treatment and to do any procedure that they deem necessary until my/our camper/s can be safely transported to a doctor or hospital.
